In accordance with this resolution, individuals from the Meitei community are not permitted to enter Churachandpur, and this measures continues to remain in force.

All concerned are required to respect and strictly adhere to the buffer zone, so as to prevent any untoward incidents and to maintain peace and stability.

Further, as per Meeting Resolution No. 2 (dated 3rd March 2026), a Grand Program will be observed on 3rd May 2026, marking the Separation Day at the Wall of Remembrance. This solemn occasion is dedicated to honoring the sacred memory of our martyrs, whose sacrifices continue to inspire our courage, resilience, and collective resolve.

In organizing this significant commemoration, the ITLF calls upon all citizens, friends, and well-wishers to stand together in a spirit of unity, purpose, and unwavering solidarity.
